12. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following constitute the minimum entry requirements into the postgraduate programmes:

- i. All applicants seeking admission into any of the Master's Degree and Postgraduate Diploma programmes must have **Five (5) Credit passes at 'O' Level** in relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two sittings.
- ii. **Postgraduate Diploma Programme**
A graduate from a recognized University with Third Class at the first degree in relevant programme may be admitted, provided the Matriculation and Departmental requirements of Ekiti State University are satisfied. A holder of a minimum of Upper Credit in HND from a recognized institution may also be admitted.
- iii. **Master's Degree Programme**
 - a. A candidate with a first degree from a recognized University having a minimum of a Second-Class Lower Division may be admitted, provided the University Matriculation and Departmental requirements are satisfied.
 - b. A candidate with a minimum of Credit 3.5 on a score of 5.0 i.e., a weighted average score of 60.0 in the Postgraduate Diploma from a recognized University may also, be admitted.
- c. **LL.M. in Law**
 - a. LL.B. degree awarded by Ekiti State University or any other recognized University with a minimum of Second Class (Honours) Lower Division.
 - b. A minimum of five (5) Credit Passes, including English Language, Mathematics and Literature in English at not more than two (2) sittings in SSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or its equivalent.
- d. **M. Phil/ Ph. D in Law**
LL.M. with Long Essay with a minimum weighted average score of not less than 55.
- iv. **M. Phil/ Ph. D.**
Candidates must possess a Master's degree in his/her area of specialization with weighted average score of 55.0 – 59.9.
- v. **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D.) Degree**
 - a. A candidate with a good Master's degree (**NOT Professional Master's degree**) with weighted average of not below 60.0 or a CGPA of 3.5 on a relative score of 5.0 in the relevant or related discipline which includes course work and a defended research dissertation from a recognized University may be admitted, provided the University Matriculation and Departmental requirements are satisfied.
 - b. A minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.50 or 60.0 weighted average score is required for candidates converting from M.Phil. to Ph.D.
 - c. In addition to these admission requirements, candidates may be required to present themselves for selection test and or interview at both Master's, M. Phil/ Ph. D. and Ph. D. Programmes.
 - d. *NOTE: In addition to the general requirements for postgraduate admission, candidates seeking admission into the Ph. D. degree programme in Electrical and Electronics Engineering MUST submit a proposal stating the specific areas of specialization and proposed topic at the point of submission of application forms and to the Department.*
 - e. *Candidates seeking admission into LL.M, M.Phil/Ph.D. and Ph.D. degrees in the Faculty of Law MUST submit a proposal stating the specific areas of specialization or subject area of their respective Thesis along with their application forms and a copy to the Faculty of Law Postgraduate Coordinator.*

13. CREDENTIALS

Photocopies of N.Y.S.C. Discharge/Exemption/Exclusion Certificate, photocopies of all credentials, including 'O'Level or its equivalents must be attached to the completed application forms. Candidates **must as well arrange for the Transcripts of their Academic Records to be sent directly to the Secretary, College of Postgraduate Studies. Non-Receipt of academic transcripts in time is at the detriment of the applicant.**

14. DURATION OF PROGRAMMES

 - b. Part-Time: A minimum of six (6) semesters and a maximum of eight (8) semesters.
- iii. **Ph. D. Programmes**
 - a. Full-Time: A minimum of six (6) semesters and a maximum of eight (8) semesters
 - b. Part-Time: A minimum of eight (8) semesters and a maximum of ten (10) semesters.
